



West Dallas Community School Uniform Requirements 2023-2024

Please pay special attention to highlighted areas.

Shoes

- **Solid white Leather** athletic shoes (“minimal to no” logo design)
- No color, designs, sparkles, patent leather, metal trim, etc.
- No metal except eye-hooks for shoe laces
- **Solid white leather only. (No cloth or mesh)**
- The soles must be white or gray.
- **No hi-tops or ¾ top at ankle. Standard sneaker only.**
- Girls may wear leather saddle-oxfords (black/white or blue /white) or Keds saddle oxfords

Stores that carry all white shoes: Dennis Uniform, Academy, Walmart, Footlocker, Payless, Finish Line.

Backpacks

- Backpacks must be **solid color or two solid colors is acceptable (no designs or graphics)**.
- No duffel style backpacks.
- You may have a legitimate backpack with two straps (no one shoulder style) with wheels, but no luggage with wheels.

P.E. Uniforms (Classes 3-8 only)

- Purchased from Dennis Uniform
- Explorers - Class 2 **do not** change for P.E.

Pants/Shorts PK-K: Navy blue long pants or navy blue shorts Classes 1-8: Navy blue long pants or navy blue shorts (with belt loops) * French Toast brand No Dickies brand or Cargo style – no side pockets. Girls' Uniform

Blouses PK-4: White Blouses with Peter Pan collar (short or long sleeve) (no puffy sleeves/no ruffle or lace collars) Classes 5-8: White Oxford cloth button down shirts (short or long sleeve) Classes 5-8: Navy knit plain polo shirt (short or long sleeve) *Undergarments: white undershirt or camisole only / no turtle-necks. Girls should not wear undergarments with color or designs (white only).	Dennis Uniform or Levines (French Toast Brand) or frenchtoast.com
Jumpers PK-4: Drop waist, scoop neck red, and blue plaid jumper * Jumper cannot be shorter than 3 inches above the floor when kneeling. *Navy blue modesty shorts must be worn under jumper.	Dennis Uniform only
Skirt Classes 5-8: red and blue plaid skirt - box pleat *Navy blue modesty shorts must be worn under skirt. *Skirt cannot be shorter than 3 inches above the floor when kneeling.	Dennis Uniform only
Socks PK-8: Crew socks only: Plain white mid-calf - No ankle or low cut socks allowed; Knee socks: plain white, cable, or opaque *During winter months: white opaque tights (with feet- no leggings), no design or colored tights	Anywhere
Sweaters PK-8: Navy vest acrylic V-Neck PK-8: Plain navy blue cardigan sweater (no hoods, shawl collars, ribbing or belts/ties) Classes 5-8: Navy polar fleece or Sweatshirt crew neck w/school crest (must fit appropriately). No hoodies are allowed to be worn in the building.	Dennis Uniform or Levines (French Toast Brand) or frenchtoast.com Dennis Uniform only (fleece / sweatshirt)

HAIR FOR SCHOOL

Each student's hair should be in keeping with the school's overall classical culture and philosophy and should not be a distraction to the learning environment. Hair must be modest and conservative and should not be a distraction to participation in the classroom or gym (PE or athletics). Therefore, fads such as designs, initials, fades, braids, mohawks, faux-hawks, twists, spike, ramps, shaved parts, and excessive use of gel (or hair products) are not allowed.

Boys:

- Hair length must be kept above the top of the eyebrows in the front, above the top of the collar in the back, and above the top of the ears.
- Hair should be generally uniform in length - not over an inch in height and/or not exposing the scalp.
- Hair should be the student's natural color.
- No facial hair is allowed.

Girls:

- Hair and any braids or extensions should be a reasonable length and the student's natural color.
- Hair worn up should be no more than three inches in height.
- Hair should be above the eyebrows in the front.
- Accessories:
 - Hair bows, headbands & ponytail holders should be a solid color either (clear, red, white, black or navy) and modest in size.
 - **No** glitter or designs of any kind. They should be plain. (Exception - School plaid may be worn.)
 - Hair beads/barrettes should be few in number, plain, and kept small in size so as not to be a distraction to the student and others. Beads/barrettes must be clear, red, white, black or navy.

JEWELRY FOR SCHOOL

Jewelry should be modest and safe as it can often be a distraction. Please use the following guidelines:

- A modest, plain watch, no designs (navy, black, brown, silver or gold band). Students may wear watches that tell the time and date; however, alarms/sounds must be turned off. Students may not bring to school watches or similar devices that have the capability to do the following (whether activated or not):
 - make or receive phone calls, texts, emails, or other messages,
 - access the internet, apps, Siri, Google, etc., (this includes Fitbits)
 - interact with social media.
- Earrings - Girls may wear small (4mm or below) white pearl studs, birthstone studs or plain stud ball shaped earrings (red, navy, white, gold, or silver). Only one earring per ear and must be worn in the earlobe. For safety reasons, no hoops or dangles are permitted.
- Boys are not allowed to wear earrings.
- Students may not wear rings, bracelets, necklaces or lanyards.
- If your child has a specific medical need that necessitates him/her wearing a **Medical Alert** necklace or bracelet that is permissible. *Please advise the student's advisory teacher and receptionist of this.*

Note: Please do not allow children to wear expensive or valuable jewelry to school.

PERSONAL GROOMING (INCLUDING NAILS AND COSMETICS) FOR SCHOOL

Uniforms should be clean, neat, and in good repair. Students should practice good grooming habits. All students, even our youngest, should be able to take care of this by themselves.

Nails must be clean and neatly trimmed. No acrylic or gel (fake) nails, nail polish, cosmetics, temporary or permanent tattoos or other markings on the skin (such as henna designs, markers, pens, stickers, etc.) Please remind your child to remove any of these before coming to school. Thank you!
